"THE WOMEN IN MY LIFE will always remain my central inspiration," says the artist Jean-Paul Goude, whose latest work appears as part of the exhibition "Image-Makers," on view at Issey Miyake's Tokyo museum, 21_21 Design Sight, through October 5. One piece, *The Waltzer*, stars Goude's "three muses"—model Farida Khelifa, singer Grace Jones, and his wife of nearly 20 years, Karen Park Goude—as large dolls that dance gracefully on a circular track. "I have always put women on a pedestal in one way or another," he says.
